



HOME ENERGY SOLUTIONS PROGRAM

Energy Efficiency Fund programs are developed, implemented and managed by Connecticut's electric and natural gas utilities. One of the most popular residential programs is the in-home services program: Home Energy Solutions.

Fee for Home Energy Solutions Program

The fee for 2010 Home Energy Solutions program services is \$75.00 for all Connecticut households regardless of how they are heated (electric, natural gas, oil or propane). The \$75.00 fee is mandated by the Connecticut Department of Public Utility Control's (DPUC) Final Decision on the 2010 Conservation & Load Management Plan dated March 17, 2010.¹

Coupons

In February 2010, the Energy Efficiency Fund issued a \$50 coupon for the Home Energy Solutions program through (1) printed Bargain Books distributed to residents across the state and (2) Bargain Book's online site: http://www.bargainbook.biz/coupons/NEUtilities_2.pdf.

- This coupon is currently good through March 31, 2010.
- As with all coupons, there is an expiration date and the purpose is to promote program sign-ups during a set, pre-determined time period by the Energy Efficiency Fund.
- Both The Connecticut Light & Power Company and The United Illuminating Company are accepting these coupons from Home Energy Solutions program contractors.
- All Connecticut residents who have the coupon must schedule an appointment with a Home Energy Solutions contractor by March 31, 2010.
- On April 1, 2010, the utilities will be given a list of scheduled appointments for April-May 2010 by all Home Energy Solutions program contractors. Coupons submitted by customers who are not listed as "scheduled" on a program contractor's list will not be honored.
- All coupons must be submitted by May 31, 2010.

The Energy Efficiency Fund reserves the right to issue (or not issue) further coupons during 2010.
