

INSTRUCTIONS:

Sounds Around – Match the sounds

- Set out the plastic eggs
- Explain to the students that they must shake the eggs, with a goal of matching two eggs with the same naturally “noisy” item.
- During the activity, ask: what do you think is inside the eggs? Have you ever heard this sound before? Where? Etc...

Answers:

<u>Egg #s</u>	<u>Item</u>
3 & 9	rocks
16 & 1	sticks
14 & 10	acorns
17 & 13	pine needles
8 & 15	seed pods
12 & 6	pine cones
7 & 2	big seeds
18 & 5	sunflower seeds
4 & 11	sand
